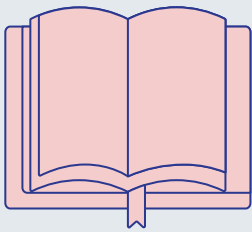

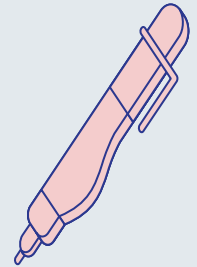


78%

of GNG students were at or above national averages in reading (in grades K-10)

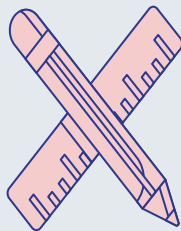
100%

of GNG students (in grades 3&4) were at or above national averages in language usage (spelling, grammar, etc.)



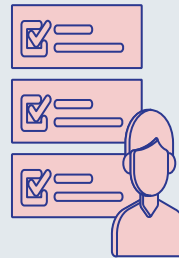
73%
